YARD WASTE SERVICE

Yard waste collection is **now included** in your rate. Please help divert compostable items from the landfill by placing yard trimmings, leaves and small branches in your yard waste cart. Rocks, dirt and food waste should not be placed in yard waste carts. Waste Management will service this cart every other week.



OVERFILLED / OVERLOADED CARTS

To reduce litter and wildlife conflicts, all trash must fit inside your cart. One additional yard waste and one additional recycling cart may be added to your account at no additional cost. Customers with overfilled carts will receive a warning and may be subject to additional charges. Excess trash (trash outside of your cart) will not be collected.



SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

Recyclables can now all be placed in the same cart. Customers with contaminated recycling may receive a notification letter and recycling guidelines. Carts with the wrong materials inside may be subject to removal. Check your recycling cart lid or use this guide to help sort properly. Please Recycle RightSM to help Carson City reach its diversion goals.



CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION

Curbside collection of Christmas trees is included in residential accounts. Collection begins the first business day after December 25 and continues weekdays through January 15. Trees may be placed inside your yard waste cart or bundled and placed beside the cart. Trees must be cut into sections no longer than (6) six feet and be free of tinsel, flock and other decorations.



HAZARDOUS WASTE/SHARPS/PHARMACEUTICALS

Keep paint, batteries, electronics, motor oil, sharps, pharmaceuticals and other hazardous materials out of the Carson City landfill. These items don't belong in trash, recycling or yard waste carts. Check your quarterly bill or home.wm.com/Carson-City for information about additional disposal events.



CURBSIDE BULKY PICKUP

Each residential customer account includes curbside bulky pickups for up to 4 large items per year, including e-waste. Please call (775) 343-7596 at least 48 hours in advance to schedule service. Items must be curbside by 6 a.m. Acceptable items include furniture and appliances. Tires, construction debris, medical waste and Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) are not acceptable. Please indicate items to be picked up when booking your appointment.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

The Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Collection Facility provides Carson City residents with free hazardous waste disposal services every Thursday afternoon between 1:30 and 4:00 p.m. by appointment only for: **Oil-based paint, Varnish, Stain, Gasoline, Pesticides, and Herbicides**

DUMP VOUCHER

Carson City residents will receive a voucher from the City in their utility bill each Spring. Vouchers are good for one free disposal at the Carson City landfill. Residents who rent in Carson City but don't get a utility bill may pick up a voucher at the Carson City Public Works office, located at 3505 Butti Way. Identification and proof of residency is required. Voucher use is limited to one pickup truck bed, and one small trailer (4 x 8 feet) filled with trash. Please remember to cover your load for transport to prevent litter.

SENIOR RATE APPLICATION

In recognition of the needs of seniors with low and fixed incomes, the Carson City Board of Supervisors has authorized a reduced rate for mandatory trash (solid waste) collection service for qualified residents. Customers who qualify will be charged 75% of the standard rate for trash (solid waste) removal. Reduced rate applications must be renewed every two years. Rate applications and qualifications are available at the WM office at 5560 Sheep Drive in Carson City or online at home.wm.com/CarsonCity.

SELF HAUL APPLICATION

Residents who routinely self-haul their trash (solid waste) to the Carson City Landfill on Flint Drive may apply for an exemption from mandatory collection service. To apply for an exemption, residents will need original receipts demonstrating landfill usage at least six (6) consecutive months prior to July 1, 2020, or original landfill receipts for at least twelve (12) consecutive months for any period after July 1, 2020. Photocopies of receipts will not be accepted. Residential customers must also complete an exemption application, which is available online at home.wm.com/carson-city or at the WM Customer Service desk. Applications should be returned to Waste Management Customer Service at 5560 Sheep Drive, Carson City, NV 89701. Records will be kept on file at this location.









Cart Set Out and General Information

- Trash is collected every week.
- Recycling and Yard Waste are collected every other week on alternating weeks.
- Wheel carts to curb by 6:00 a.m. on your collection day. Carts should be placed side-by-side at least 3 feet apart. Set out so wheels are against the curb or edge of pavement.
- Do not overload carts; lids must close. Please contact WM for information about an additional cart if necessary.
- Please sort properly (see guide inside).
- Holiday Schedule: Collection Holidays coincide with holidays at Carson City Landfill, which are New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. When the holiday lands on a week day, collection will be one day later for rest of the week.

Brown lid cart. No liquid, food or plastic bags please.













No food waste please. Acceptable material includes any vegetative matter resulting from normal yard and landscaping maintenance that is not more than 3 feet in its longest dimension or 6 inches in diameter. Yard Waste includes plant debris, such as grass clippings, leaves, pruning, weeds, branches, brush, and other forms of vegetative waste.











NO branches more than 3 feet in length, more than 6 inches in diameter or weighing more than 50 lbs. NO Tree Stumps, Bamboo, Soil, Dirt, Rocks, Concrete, Asphalt, Plastic Bags, Animal Waste, Palm Tree Branches, Painted Wood, Treated Wood
