



Regift Your Tree by Recycling it

Give your tree back to Mother Earth after your holiday celebrations. City of La Verne residents may recycle their trees during the first week following Christmas on their scheduled collection day on **December 26th** and **January 2nd**. Trees will be collected at the curb and may be picked up by special bed trucks. After the week period, you may cut your tree and place the pieces in your green waste carts with the lids completely closed.

Remember:

- Trees taller than six feet must be cut in half.
- Residents are asked to remove decorations, including tinsel, lights, ornaments and tree stands from their tree.
- Residents are reminded that flocked trees cannot be recycled. They will be collected by the trash collector.

Holiday Reminder

Waste collection does not occur on the holidays below. For the remainder of the week following a holiday, collection will be pushed back one day. If the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, collection will not be affected.

Free Battery Recycling program for Residents of La Verne

Collect your Household Batteries and Deposit into the Battery Kiosks.

Acceptable Household Batteries include:

- AA, AAA, C, D
- NiCad—rechargeable
- Alkaline/Zinc-Carbon—one time use
- Lithium Primary—one time use
- Nickel Zinc—one time use
- Silver Oxide—one time use (used in hearing aids)
- Nickel Metal Hydride—rechargeable (used in cell phones)
- Lithium Ion—rechargeable (used in computers and cell phones)
- Mercury batteries—one time use (used in hearing aids and watches)
- Cell Phones

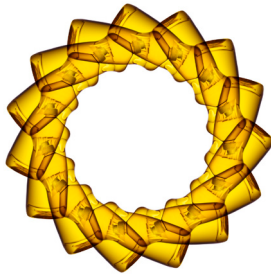

New State Recycling Laws Affect Businesses and You!

La Verne businesses need your help. The State of California has a mandate to have 50% of all trash diverted to recycling facilities by 2020. If these mandates are not met, cities that have not reached the 50% recycle level may receive fines from the state. This will trickle down to the businesses and ultimately, you the consumer.
