Residential Solid Waste and Recycling Program Information

Waste Management provides a wheeled cart for trash, recyclables, and green waste. The carts are picked up every week.

WHAT GOES IN YOUR CART?

Waste Management supplies trash (burgundy), green waste (green) and commingled recycling (grey) containers.

TRASH

(WM supplied burgundy cart)

The trash cart is for household waste that cannot be recycled. Remember to place all refuse inside the containers and all recyclables and green waste in their appropriate container.

GREEN WASTE CART

(WM supplied green cart)

Green waste materials include:

- Grass / Leaves
- Tree Branches
- Plants / Weeds
- Garden Trimmings

(No: palm fronds, soil, rocks, manure or animal waste)

***Do not place green waste in plastic bags**

RECYCLING CART

(WM supplied grey cart)

Recyclable materials include:

- Newspapers
- Cardboard
- Mixed Paper
- Junk Mail
- Cereal Boxes
- Magazines & Phone Books
- Aluminum Cans
- Tin / Steel Cans
- Plastic Bottles
- All Colors of Glass / Plastic Containers

***Do not place recyclables in plastic bags**

NOTE: Additional trash, recycle, and green waste carts are available for a nominal fee. Contact Waste Management at (800) 423-9986 or www.wm.com for more information.

CART SERVICE REMINDERS

1. Place all waste in the appropriate container and close the lid.
2. All trash, recyclables, and green waste outside the cart will not be collected.
3. Place your carts at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on collection day. Emptied carts must be removed from curbside by 6:00 p.m. on the same day.
4. Roll carts into the street, place them against the curb and handles facing your home. Place carts at least two feet apart from other carts and objects.
5. Do not place recyclables and green waste in plastic bags.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Waste collection does not occur on the following holidays:

- New Year's Day
- Labor Day
- Memorial Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- 4th of July
- Christmas Day

When a holiday falls a weekday, collection will be delayed one day for the remainder of the week. If a holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, there will be no delays.

WM EZ PAY

You can conveniently pay your bill online with Waste Management's EZ Pay program. Simply visit wm.com/myaccount to get started.

BILLING

Residential services are billed quarterly, in advance, by Waste Management. For your convenience, you may pay your invoice online at www.wm.com/myaccount or you can pay over the phone for a small fee. Unpaid and delinquent charges for waste collection services will be placed on resident's property taxes annually, including penalties and interest.

BULKY GOODS COLLECTION

Residents with curbside cart service may request two times in a calendar year, the free pick up of household bulky items. Additional bulky items are available at a nominal cost. Bulky items include: couches, washers, dryers, refrigerators, water heaters, lawn furniture, TV's, computer monitors, etc. Bulky items do not include large items such as car bodies or construction and demolition waste, tires, hazardous waste or any other items that cannot be handled by two persons.

CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING

Waste Management will collect and recycle Christmas trees from December 26 for three (3) consecutive weeks at no additional charge. Trees longer than six (6) feet must be cut in half. Please remove all decorations including tinsel, lights, ornaments and tree stands. Flocked trees will be collected by the trash truck and cannot be recycled. Bundled brush and clippings not placed in the Green Waste containers may be picked up as a bulky item pickup. In addition, extra Green Waste carts may be added to your regular service for an additional fee.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Household hazardous waste cannot be collected by Waste Management. Please call the Riverside County Waste Management Department (800) 304-2226 or (951) 486-3200 or you can visit them on the web at <http://www.rcwaste.org>. Household hazardous waste includes: used oil filters, paint, antifreeze, batteries, propane tanks, pesticides, household cleaners, pool chemicals, sharps/needles, and fluorescent bulbs.

TEMPORARY BIN AND ROLL-OFF SERVICE

Large bins are available for rent to help you dispose of waste from home remodeling, major landscaping, roofing, or other big household projects. For rate and other information, please call the Waste Management Service Center at (800) 423-9986.

DISPOSAL OF USED MOTOR OIL

Waste Management offers free pickup of residentially generated used motor oil. Please contact Waste Management customer service (800) 423-9986 at least 24 hours in advance of our regular collection date.

SHARPS

Residents can conveniently and responsibly dispose of needles, lancets, and other sharps from their own homes with Waste Management's mail back containers. Residents simply call Waste Management's customer service at (800) 423-9986 to request their free container and a WM representative will deliver it to their home the following week. On an annual basis, residents will receive one free Sharps Mail-Back container, with a second and third kit available for a nominal fee. Limit one at a time.

COMPOST BINS

Waste Management offers a unique composting opportunity to Menifee Residents who may elect to have a composting bin in lieu of a greenwaste cart. There will be no additional fee for the cost of the composting bin valued at \$55.00 each. Call Waste Management's customer service to request your compost bin today.
