Dear Paloma Creek Resident,
Waste Management is pleased to be the provider of waste services for Paloma Creek. Like Paloma Creek, Waste Management is focused on sustainability- creating, deploying, and nurturing community programs aimed at inspiring change for a greener tomorrow.

Residential Collection

Waste Management provides waste collection, recycling, brush, and bulk pick-up services.

Paloma Creek residents should use the blue cart for recyclables. The green cart should be used for items considered trash. See the right side of this page for a description of what goes into the recycle bin and what would be considered trash.

Waste Management provides the following service to Paloma Creek residents:

- Weekly trash collection- Wednesdays
- Every-other-week recycling collection- new recycling cart only
- Once-a-week brush/bulk pick up- Wednesdays

Waste Management is proud to be your choice service provider.



How the Program Works

- On Wednesdays, place your cart(s) and your bulk/ brush out for collection no later than 7 AM.
- Recycling service will be the same as your trash collection day, every other week on Wednesdays.
- After collection, remove your cart(s) from the alley or street and store in a secure and convenient location.
- Do not over fill carts; the lids must remain closed to prevent littering.
- Do not place recyclable items outside the cart.
- Do not place anything in the recycling cart that is not listed on the lid.
- Do not leave the cart(s) on the street or in the alley where it may be stolen or damaged.

Additional Program Information

- For additional questions not answered in this flyer, call Waste Management customer service at 800-772-8653.
- If your cart is lost or stolen, please file a police report and then call Mustang Water Utility District for a replacement, 940-440-9561.
- There is a list of accepted recyclable materials on the lid of the cart. This will serve as a reminder. All items may be placed in the cart together, no separation is required. Please rinse all containers before placing them in the cart. Do not place an item in the cart except what is listed as acceptable.
- All household trash must be placed in the polycart with the exception of brush and bulk items. Brush and bulk is limited to one cubic yard (3ft. x 3ft. x 3ft.) per week. Brush must be in bundles weighing no more than 50 pounds and be no more than 4 feet in length and no more than 3 inches in diameter.
- **What is a bulk item?** A bulk item is an appliance, piece of furniture, or other residential items that are too large for the container. Paloma Creek residents are limited to 1 cubic yard of bulk items per a week.



When Paloma Creek residents use **Recycle Often Recycle Right** SM, great things happen. By recycling everyday items like those shown below, tons of raw materials, time, energy, and money are saved. Use your blue cart, with the imprinted recycling instructions, to place all your recyclables together- no sorting needed! Place your cart at the curb before 7 AM on every-other-Wednesday. Below is a list of common items that can be recycled.
