KEEPING RIDGECREST CLEAN

Like you, Waste Management is proud to call Ridgecrest home. We care about how our community looks and want to help local residents, businesses and contractors make smart choices about disposing of their temporary and industrial waste. This step-by-step guide will assist you in planning for your service needs.

PLANNING YOUR PROJECT

From backyard cleanups to new construction, Waste Management has the right disposal solution for your project. Before you start, decide the following:

- What type(s) of material(s) are you disposing of?
- How long will the project take me to complete?
- Are you required to comply with CALGreen mandates, which includes recycling or salvaging 50% of your project's construction and demolition debris?

ORDERING YOUR SERVICE

- Review the Container Reference Guide on the reverse side of this page for common container types and sizes available.
- Make a note of your specific service requirements, such as project location, size of container(s) needed and frequency of service.
- Contact Customer Service at (800) 266-7551 to place your order.

COMPLETING YOUR PROJECT

- Place your waste materials in the container, loading heavy items first and spreading the load evenly. All materials must fit within the container, allowing for the lid to be closed or container to be tarped upon service.
- Do not overload or overfill the container as they cannot be serviced.
- Do not dispose of any hazardous waste materials, such as: paint, oil, chemicals, tires, batteries, hot ashes, florescent bulbs, electronic waste, medical waste or animal waste. If these materials are present, the container cannot be serviced.

Construction and Demolition Recycling (C&D) Requirements

To meet State of California CALGreen mandates, most projects are required to provide verification that at least 50% of all construction and demolition debris and inert materials are recycled. Waste Management is proud to offer C&D diversion service, recycling up to 80% of a project's waste, including: aluminum, asphalt, concrete, plastic, rebar, steel and wood.
