Collection for trash, recycling and yard trimmings once a week starting at 7a.m. on your designated service day.



Trash Service

Once per week fully automated curbside trash collection utilizing a 96-gallon cart with green lid.

- Must have a 96-gallon trash cart provided by Waste Management.
- Place trash cart at the curb with handle facing your home.
- Container lid must close tightly.

Excess Trash must be bagged and tagged. Tags are available at The Woodlands Township offices and service counters at local grocery stores for \$1.75 (Attach one tag to each bag).

Yard Trimmings

Once per week on scheduled collection day. Grass clippings, leaves and branches can be bundled, put in open 30-gallon containers, or use compostable bags, weighing less than 40 pounds. Place 4' from 96-gallon carts.



Bulk Items

A bulk item is an appliance, piece of furniture or some other residential item that's too large to fit in the trash cart if it were empty.

Holiday Schedule

The following holidays are observed only when they occur on a weekday.

Christmas Day

Any holiday falls on a Monday through Friday will cause all subsequent solid waste services for the week to be delayed by one day. For example, Friday service will occur on Saturday.



Single-Stream Recycling Service

Once per week fully automated curbside collection of recyclables utilizing a 96-gallon cart with yellow lid.

Empty cereal and cracker boxes and tubes.

Remove lids before recycling.
